



TUITION AND FEES

There is a one time non-refundable registration fee of \$50 per family. Space is limited and this will hold a space for your child. After registration forms are submitted, you will be notified with confirmation of your child's enrollment.

Tuition Worksheet:

The total days the child attends during the year will be calculated, then multiplied by the daily tuition rate and then divided into 9 equal payments, plus a prorated 10th payment for August (Sept-May, August is prorated).

Tuition is based on \$50 day per child for full day, and \$30 day for half day. The total number of days of full-time child is approx. 180 school days a year (36 weeks). Example: Your child will attends 3 days a week x 36 weeks = approx. 108 days of attendance. 108 days of attendance x \$50 a day rate = \$5400. \$5400 / 10 months = \$540 monthly tuition fee.

Thus approx tuition fees are as follows (note, will change slightly when August is prorated):

FULL DAY:

1 day a week: \$180 a month
2 days a week: \$360 a month
3 days a week: \$540 a month
4 days a week: \$720 a month
5 days a week: \$900 a month

HALF DAY:

1 day a week: \$108 a month
2 days a week: \$216 a month
3 days a week: \$324 a month
4 days a week: \$432 a month
5 days a week: \$540 a month

Whether the enrolled child is in attendance or not, no adjustment in tuition will be made. Tuition covers time reserved not just time used. Once a spot is reserved for a child, supplies are purchased and other children may be turned away due to a full ratio. Therefore, the fees the parent pays are not refundable or available for credit to another month. Refunds are not available for illness, occasional absences, snow days, vacations, days closed or early withdrawal during the month.

NOTE: I will calculate your tuition by counting the exact number of days your child is enrolled for. In the case of mid-year enrollment, we would use this method and just count up exact days remaining in that calendar year. The above approx tuition is based on 10 equal payments, payment amount will change when August is prorated, and payment is based on 9 equal payments.
